Institute-Village Interface

The Institute-Village interface is one of the major components of Extension Research. Periodic training programmes / awareness campaigns are being conducted to the sugarcane farmers in the villages in and around Coimbatore district. A number of field days have been organized by this Institute in nearby villages wherein sugarcane production technologies are explained to the farmers by interactive meetings involving the Scientists of the Institute and the local farmers, the latest one conducted on 28 November 2013 in Perunthalaiyur village, Erode district. A number of **front-line demonstrations** had been conducted in the villages over the past several years demonstrating improved crop production technologies to the farmers. The following is a list of most recently conducted demonstrations in the nearby villages:
