GUIDELINES FOR EVALUATION OF NOMINATION FORM FOR THE FELLOW OF SSRD

(Applicable for Sugarcane Research Personnel)

- 1. All members of the Society having a continuous standing for five years are eligible to be considered for the FELLOW of the Society.
- 2. A Member of SSRD may apply for this award 5 times during his/her membership period.
- 3. Any life member can propose/ second a member for the award during first five year (2019-2023), thereafter only FELLOWS of the society propose/ second the nominations.
- 4. Nomination Form should be signed by both the Proposer and the Seconder.
- 5. A Proposer can nominate maximum TWO persons and the Seconder maximum THREE persons in a year.
- 6. The number of FELLOWs admitted each year shall be restricted to a maximum of FIVE. On alternate year, one member from sugar industry / sugarcane development side will be admitted.
- 7. There will be a separate proforma for Research and Industry personnel. Use appropriate one.
- 8. The number of FELLOW shall not exceed 30% of total number of the life members of the Society.
- 9. The candidates proposed for the award should have made substantial contributions in the field of either research or development in sugarcane or sugar industry for a minimum period of 15 years.
- 10. The recognition of members for the FELLOW of SSRD will be discussed and finalized in the Executive Council. The decision of the EC will be the final and it will be announced in the Annual General Body meeting of the Society.
- 11. The cut-off mark for award of FELLOW is 70.
- 12. Proforma with incomplete information is liable for rejection. No communication will be made in this regard.
- 13. Proofs for claims made in the applications should be attached.
- 14. While quoting your publications, please consult the catalogue of journals with NAAS scores and list only those publications that have been published in NAAS rated journals. *Please avoid publication in non-refereed journals and do not list papers from the proceedings/ abstracts presented in workshops/ symposia.*
- 15. Members / Applicant can't claim the Award as matter of their rights.
- 16. The President of SSRD reserves all rights to accept or reject the application(s).
- 17. Last date for submission of Nomination is on or before 5.30 PM of 21st Oct 2024
- 18. No updates/reprints/additional information shall be considered after that date.
- 19. Duly completed Nomination Form should be sent by the Proposer or the Seconder to the General Secretary, Society for Sugarcane Research and Development (SSRD), ICAR-Sugarcane Breeding Institute & PO, Coimbatore-641007 on or before due date.
