

## **GUIDELINES FOR EVALUATION OF NOMINATION FORM FOR YOUNG RESEARCHER AWARD OF SSRD**

1. This award will be presented to Members of SSRD who have a continuous standing for FIVE years in the Society and not attained the age of 40 years on 31<sup>st</sup> August of the year in which the award was announced, in recognition of their talent, creativity and contribution in the field of sugarcane research and development.
2. The number of awards to be made in any year will be limited to ONE.
3. In the first three years from 2020, a candidate for the award may be proposed by “Life Member” of SSRD. Afterwards a candidate shall be nominated by “Fellow” of SSRD, or by earlier recipients of this award. Self-nomination will not be considered.
4. A nomination will remain valid for consideration by the Society for 2 YEARS or the eligibility age whichever expires earlier. However, the candidate who wishes to make his nomination for the second year may send a message to the Society along with updates etc. if available but no need to send nomination form again.
5. The names of the Young Scientists selected for the award will be announced in annual General body meeting of the Society or similar such meeting.
6. The award shall consist of a Bronze Medal and a Certificate. All members of the Society having a continuous standing for five years are eligible to be considered for Young Researcher Award of the Society.
7. A proposer can nominate maximum for TWO awards in a year.
8. All the valid nominations will be discussed and finalized in the Executive Council. The decision of the EC will be announced in the annual General Body meeting of the Society.
9. Proforma with incomplete information is liable for rejection. No communication will be made in this regard.
10. The cut-off marks for the deciding the eligibility for the award is 60.0 (SIXTY)
11. The President of SSRD reserves all rights to accept or reject the application(s).
12. Proofs for claims made in the applications should be attached.
13. While quoting your publications, please consult the catalogue of journals with NAAS scores and list only those publications that have been published in NAAS rated journals. *Avoid publication in non-refereed journals and do not list papers from the proceedings/ abstracts presented in workshops/ symposia.*
14. Members / Applicant can't claim the Award as matter of their rights.
15. **Last date for submission of Nomination is on or before 5.30 PM of 21<sup>st</sup> Oct 2024**
16. Duly completed nomination Form should be sent by Post, Courier or by Hand, to Secretary, Society for Sugarcane Research and Development (SSRD), ICAR-Sugarcane Breeding Institute, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu-641007 on or before the due date.

A	The nominees should list maximum of 15 best research publications in sugarcane along with latest NAAS's journal rating. The sum total of NAAS score for 20 publications will be divided by 6 to obtain marks. For journals not covered by NAAS, but having International Impact Factor (Thomson Reuters), the nominee can indicate score as 6 + Impact Factor. For research publications, where NAAS journal rating / International Impact Factor (Thomson Reuters) is not available, award 0.5 marks for each publication. <i>No need to attach reprint of publications</i>	Full marks /scores for first author or corresponding author; 75% marks/ score for others	15.0
B	Other publications	Books not less than 100 pages -1.0 for the First author and 0.5 for other authors; Book chapters/ short communications, pamphlets, popular articles, symposia/ conference papers etc. 0.5 for first Author, 0.25 for other Authors	5.0
